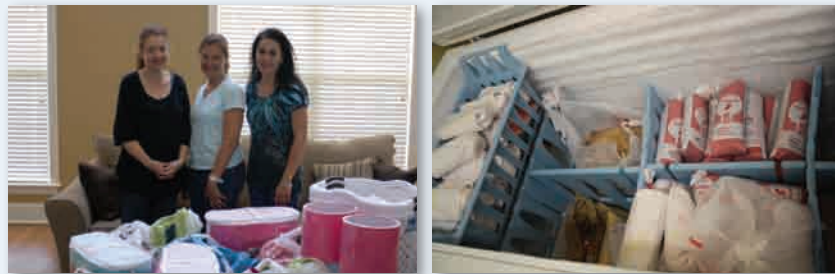

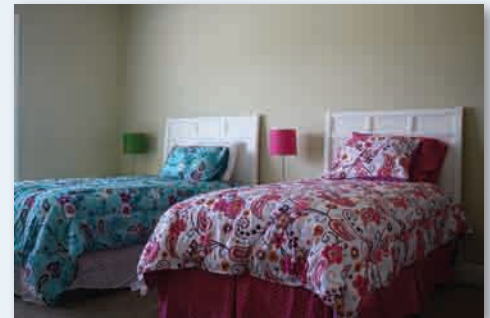


## CROSSPOINT COMMUNITY CHURCH SMALL GROUP HELPS IN BIG WAYS

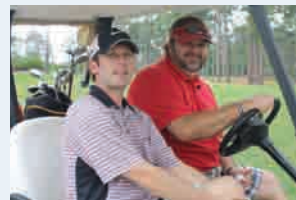
